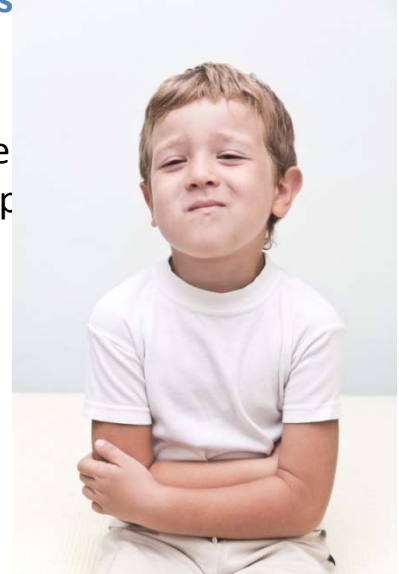

## About the Study

- Clinical diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder (ASD)
- Clinical diagnosis of constipation

- Evaluation by a psychologist
- Evaluation and treatment by a gastrointestinal specialist
