About the study

The registry collects clinical information on patients with ASDs in order to identify common conditions associated with ASDs and treatments for these conditions.

Purpose of the registry?

- To better understand the factors associated with ASD
- To improve and standardize the care of children with ASDs across multiple specialties.

Who can participate?

- Children ages **2-17 years**
- Diagnosed with an **ASD**
- Is a Center patient
- **English-speaking** of any ethnicity

Participation involves

- Filling out questionnaires/Completing Interviews at regular clinical visits
- Clinical Follow up over 3 years
- Administration of the ADOS, if child has not had one administered within the last year.
